Why the is cost \$120?

Can I bring my own instrument?

Yes, we encourage you to.

What if I am unable to bring my own instrument?

We would recommend that you borrow one, as at this stage Unidos de Sydney does not own any instruments.

How will I learn the songs?

Once you have paid your participation fee you will be sent a registration form to complete. Once we receive all of your contact details you will be added to our closed Facebook page, administered by Mestre Marcelo.

This page will give you access to practice videos Mestre Marcelo has personally created that will enable you to practice at home and also communicate with other Bateria members in your state and organise additional training sessions.

I am interstate or from overseas, can I still participate?

Of course! everyone is welcome to join. We understand that you may miss the first two ensaios which is why we will be creating the online videos for you to practice at home.

When is the parade taking place?

The parade will take place on Friday 15th March 2019 @ 7pm at the Parramasala Multicultural Festival. More detailed information regarding marshalling times and locations will be released closer to the date.

Will we have a rehearsal on the day?

There will be no rehearsal on the day, final rehearsal will take place the day before on the 14th of March.
